Church Matching Scholarship Program

► This program has been developed to encourage churches to provide scholarship support for their students preparing to serve Christ in the church, society, and the world.

It is not designed to match wages, internship monies, or gifts from individuals for specific students.

> Guidelines:

- 1. Philadelphia Biblical University will match up to \$500 per year for each **full-time** student enrolled in PBU's Advance Degree Completion Program. This scholarship will be credited to the student's first and third semesters only. **Church scholarships above this amount may be given to students, but they will not be matched by PBU.**
- 2. A church official must **submit the attached form along with all checks, payable to Philadelphia Biblical University, by December 1, for the Fall Semester or August 1 for the Spring Semester.** Forms and checks received after the deadline will be credited to the account of the student but will not be matched.
- 3. It is the responsibility of the student to know how the donation from the church and the match by Philadelphia Biblical University will be coordinated with other financial aid. The student is responsible to follow-up with the church to ensure

information is submitted before the deadline.

- 4. Donations will be accepted from church and parachurch organizations only. Personal checks and gifts from other types of agencies will not qualify for matching funds. Donations for the Church Matching Scholarship Program must not come from wages that would be received on an hourly or salaried basis. Volunteer workers are prohibited from receiving compensatory gifts through this program as well.

- 5. Philadelphia Biblical University will withhold the institutional portion of the award until the student has submitted appropriate paperwork. Institutional funds will be credited after enrollment has been verified.
