Music Scholarships & Audition Information

Scholarships ranging from \$3,000 to \$15,000 will be awarded to music students who successfully pass their audition and exhibit outstanding performance ability and potential. The scholarship award will be applied toward PBU tuition, one-tenth awarded each semester of full-time study up to ten semesters. To qualify, applicants must meet PBU's entrance requirements and audition before May 1, 2005. If scholarship funds remain after May 1, additional scholarships may be awarded. **Up to \$126,000 will be awarded annually.**

AUDITION REQUIREMENTS

Church Music, Performance, and Music Education Applicants must:

- perform two classical and one sacred hymn/song arrangement (*memorization* required for voice and keyboard applicants; optional for instrumental).
- demonstrate sight-reading ability and aural skills.
- play all major and minor harmonic scales.

Composition applicants must, in addition to the above audition requirements, enter the composition program in one of two ways:

- submit a portfolio of original compositions at the audition.
OR
- for prospective students just beginning their compositional study, demonstrate, during the first four semesters of study, a working knowledge of theory and a strong interest in the creative process.

Audition is only in applied area of study, no piano proficiency is required.

Applicants must bring one reference copy of all music to the audition. All applicants should provide their own accompanist unless other arrangements are made with the School of Music and Performing Arts. Applicants requesting an accompanist must mail one copy of all music with their audition application.

Please note that acceptance into the School of Music and Performing Arts does not constitute acceptance into the University or vice versa. You must be accepted by the University in addition to successfully completing your audition requirements.

NOTIFICATION

Applicants will be informed of audition and music scholarship results in an interview following the audition.
