PUTTING CONTEST RULES

1. The Putting Contest shall consist of three rounds.
 2. Round One is available to all participants in PBU's Golf Classic and shall occur during registration time (8:00-10am) on the putting green. Each player shall be allowed one putt.
 3. The ten individuals with putts closest to the hole in Round One shall advance to Round Two. The Contest Director shall determine which ten putts are closest to the hole during Round One, and his judgments shall be final.
 4. Round Two shall occur immediately after Round one. The three individuals with putts closest to the hole in Round Two shall advance to Round Three. The Contest Director shall determine which three putts are closest to the hole during Round Two, and his judgments shall be final.
 5. Round Three shall occur directly after the completion of Round Two, with putts taken during this Round coming from a different direction than all other qualifying putts. Round Three will feature the 3 finalists putting on a natural surface a minimum distance of 75 feet for a prize of \$5,000. Each finalist who sinks the putt in the final round will receive the prize. In addition, Philadelphia Biblical University will also be awarded a prize of \$5,000 per winner for the PBU athletic programs.
- * All contestants get only one putt per Round of the contest.
 - * Practice putts, mulligans and substituted putts for other players are not permitted during the Putting Contest.
 - * All disputes, matters of disagreement and so forth shall be settled by the DuPont Club Pro, and his judgement shall be final.
 - * **All putting Contest Rules are written to conform with the Certificate Conditions provided by the National Hole-in-One Association of Dallas, Texas. Any above Rule in seeming conflict in the Certificate Conditions is subordinate to the Certificate Conditions and is to be Interpreted in light of the Certificate Conditions, not vice-versa. A copy of the Certificate Conditions is available for inspection.**
