

# What to Bring to Heritage Hall



- **The Basics**

- 3M Command removable wall products (hooks, pictures, & poster strips, etc.)
- notebooks, pens, & other office supplies
- stationery & stamps
- day planner & wall calendar
- posters & other room decorations
- laundry bag or basket
- quarters for laundry/laundry detergent/fabric softener/dryer sheets
- clothes drying rack
- travel sewing kit
- umbrella and/or raincoat
- clothes hangers
- closet bar or door shoe organizer
- stackable crates
- bulletin board and/or dry erase board
- small tool kit
- sports equipment (racquets, etc.)
- bike & bike lock (outside storage only)

- **Bed & Bath Items**

- pillow & pillowcases
- blankets, comforter, & standard size sheets (2 sets?)
- area rug (9 x 11 feet or smaller)
- personal toiletries
- shower caddy
- hairdryer
- towels and bathrobe
- wastebasket(s)
- air freshener(s)
- curtains with tension rod (optional)

- **Electronics**

- refrigerator (4/5 cu. ft. or less)
- toaster (2 or 4-slice only)
- a reliable alarm clock
- stereo/CD/mp3 player
- iron & small ironing board
- camera w/ memory cards
- surge protector & electrical strips
- coffee maker and/or hot pot
- extension cord (shorter than 15 ft.)
- flashlight/batteries
- cell phone or calling cards (there are no room phones)
- computer with wireless card and printer (with extra ink)
- USB flash drive(s)
- floor lamp(s)
- fan (all rooms are air conditioned)

\* While not all of the items listed are crucial, they will provide you with the most comfortable experience within a resident hall at Philadelphia Biblical University

- **What NOT to Bring**

- halogen lamps, octopus lamps, or space heaters
- non-UL listed electronics
- microwave oven, toaster oven or foreman grill
- cooking appliances w/ exposed heating coils
- cooking appliances that do not shut off automatically (crock pots, etc.)
- pets (fish are allowed, see next item)
- aquariums over 10 gallons
- weapons or fireworks of any kind
- candles and/or incense
- alcoholic beverages, tobacco, illegal substances or paraphernalia
